Working livery Agreement (Short Term - Less than 30 Days)

1. As from the date of this agreement, Grove House Stables will care for the horse or pony 7 days a week, in return for the use of the animal and tack in the Riding School, at a reduced livery fee. Advance notice is required by Grove House Stables, if the owner wishes to use the horse at a time when it would normally be available for use in the Riding School. **If for any reason the animal is unable to work in the riding school, the full livery fee will apply, for the period of time concerned. Also, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Eve & New Year's day will be charged at full livery. (Full livery £20.00 per day).**
2. Grove House Stables strongly recommends that the owner should take out their own insurance policy to cover death, theft, vets fees etc. A passport is also the owner's responsibility. A copy of the Horse or Ponies Passport must be kept with Grove House Stables
3. A fee of £11.25 per day if under 14.2hh or £13.00 per day if 14.2hh and over, will be charged. This fee includes the provision of straw/ shavings (1.5 bales per week maximum) bedding, hay, mucking out, turning out, grooming, feeding, watering, rugging up and exercising. The fee does not include worming, veterinary fees, shoeing and insurance, clipping, trimming & rug washing.
4. Extra bedding can be supplied at an extra cost.
5. A "B.S.I." approved riding hat must be worn at all times whilst riding on our premises.
6. This agreement can be terminated on either side, by giving three weeks written notice.
7. The owner is responsible for the cost of worming the horse or pony every 8 to 13 weeks (depending upon the type of wormer used). Invoices will be forwarded to the owner. Owners must follow Grove House Stables worming programme. All horses or ponies must be wormed on arrival at the yard.
8. The owner will need to provide both a New Zealand rug and a warm Stable rug for use in cold weather.
9. We request that the owner should mark all items of equipment with their name. It is also a good idea to compile an inventory of equipment, a copy of which can be left with ourselves.
10. The owner should ensure that the horse or pony is fully inoculated against equine flu and tetanus, and that a booster is given annually.
11. Grove House Stables reserves the right to call in a veterinary surgeon to attend to the horse, if at any time it is thought necessary. Veterinary fees are the responsibility of the owner.
