

I-Pegasus CIC has been awarded funding from British Equestrian Federation's Together Fund project: which will initially support a cohort of children, aged eight and over, from low socio-economic backgrounds or who may benefit from SEMH (social, emotional and mental health) support, through their six-week 'Participate 'programme using The British Horse Society Changing Lives Through Horses Programme. The aim of this project is to build participants' confidence, communication skills and resilience each week, whilst enjoying their time with horses in the countryside environment. I-Pegasus CIC uses horse intervention – an experience or develop further skills of handling, grooming, horse knowledge and horse riding to develop life skills.

The first six week block runs from 3.1.23, the second block runs from 21.2.23 sessions run from 5.30-7.30 To apply to be considered for the project completion of the referral form by 12.12.22 is required. The program is fully funded and will require a feedback form completed at the end of the program. Places are strictly limited.
